NON-IMMIGRANT VISA (O) FOR RETIREMENT

Purpose: To retire in Thailand

Qualifications:

- Applicant must be at least 50 years old
- Not being prohibited from entering Thailand under Immigration Act B.E. 2522 (1979)
- Have no criminal record against the security of Thailand and the applicant's country of origin
- Not having prohibitive diseases (leprosy, tuberculosis, drug addiction, elephantiasis and third step of syphilis) as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 B.E. 2535 (1992)

Required Documents:

1. Completed visa application form
2. Original passport with at least 6-month validity and 2 blank visa pages
3. A copy of passport (ID page)
4. A passport size photo (white/ blue background and taken within the past 6 months)
5. Bank statement with a minimum deposit of 800,000 Thai baht or Income Certificate with a minimum monthly income of 65,000 Thai baht
6. Medical certificate issued in Malaysia within the last 3 months showing no prohibitive diseases as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 B.E. 2535 (1992)
7. Certified criminal record in the applicant's country of origin or current country of residence, issued by competent authority within the last 3 months
8. A copy of marriage or birth certificate (if also applying for dependant)

Visa fees:

- RM 300 for single entry visa
- Fee is exempted for nationals of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia

In submitting the application, I understand that:

- Additional documents may be requested as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy
- The application may be rejected without reason provided and the fees cannot be refunded
